This reprint of a very rare book was of considerable interest to historical students, and their interest in the book naturally awakened an interest in its author; hence, the frequent enquiry, Who was Christopher Levett? The most that was known about him was that he was a Yorkshireman, and that when he wrote his book, he was living at Sherborne, in Dorsetshire.
