However, this does not mean that black protagonists are over-averaged disabled. The inability of seeing refers more to a special type of blindness: a psychical one. This kind of disablement is a matter of the construction of [the] inner eyes, those eyes with which [one] look[s] through [the] physical eyes upon reality (Ellison, Ralph. *Invisible Man*. London: Penguin Books, 1965. p.7). It is a way of refusing to recognise people and their character traits, which African Americans were often confronted with. This ignorance of the - mainly - white society is picked out as a central theme in many African American novels and, therefore, it will be the topic of this publishing. To prove this thesis, the following analysis will examine some example scenes from Ralph Ellison s 1952 published novel *Invisible Man*. As one single book is not sufficient to establish a thesis for a whole genre, additionally scenes from Richard Wright s 1940 published novel *Native Son* and Ann Petry s 1946 published novel *The Street* will be briefly analysed. Even though a comparison between all three novels would have been interesting as well, this work will take its main focus on one single novel, to go as deeply into detail as the limited space allows, instead of giving only a cursory overview of different works.
